

# **IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTIFICATIONS**

When using an electrical appliance, basic precautions should always be followed, including the following:

# **A WARNING:** To reduce the risk of fire, electrical shock or injury:

- Shock Hazard. Do not put the vacuum in water or other liquid.
- Use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- Do not use with damaged cord or plug. If appliance is not working as it should, has been dropped, damaged, left outdoors, or dropped into water, return it to a service center or dispose of it according to your local waste and disposal guidelines.
- Do not pull or carry by cord, use cord as a handle, close a door on cord, or pull cord around sharp edges or corners. Do not run appliance over cord. Keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- Do not unplug by pulling on cord. To unplug, grasp the plug, not the cord.
- Do not allow the cord to hang over the edge of a table or counter or touch hot surfaces. The unit should be placed or mounted away from sinks and hot surfaces.
- Do not put any object into openings. Do not use with any opening blocked; keep free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce air flow.
- Keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, and all parts of body away from openings and moving parts.
- Do not use to pick up flammable or combustible liquids, such as gasoline, or use in areas where they may be present.
- Do not pick up anything that is burning or smoking, such as cigarettes, matches, or hot ashes.
- Do not pick up toxic material (i.e. chlorine bleach, ammonia, drain cleaner, etc.)
- Do not vacuum toner (for laser printer, copy machines etc.) as there is a risk of fire and explosion.
- Do not vacuum plaster, cement etc. as the filter can become blocked.
- . Do not use the vacuum without all the filters fitted.
- Do not operate outdoors. This appliance is intended for household use only and not for commercial
  or industrial use.
- Do not operate on wet floor or moist conditions, e.g bathroom. Water and moisture could damage the circuit board.
- · Do not handle plug with wet hands.
- Use extra caution when cleaning on stairs.
- Plug the plug directly into an electrical outlet.
- Use the plug only in a standard electrical outlet (120V/60Hz).
- Unplug the plug from outlet before any routine cleaning or maintenance.
- Do not look into the air vents when the unit is switched on, as sometimes small debris can be discharged, especially after cleaning or replacing the filter.
- Do not leave appliance unattended when plugged in.
- Do not allow appliance to be used as a toy. Close attention is necessary when used by or near children.
- Turn off the switch before unplugging
  - \* Polarized Plugs (one blade is wider than the other) are used on equipment to reduce the risk of electric shock. When provided, this plug will fit in the polarized outlet only one way.

# ADDITIONAL SAFETY WARNINGS

# A WARNING:

- Prevent unintentional starting. Ensure the switch is in the off-position before picking up or carrying the appliance.
- Have servicing performed by a qualified repair person using only identical replacement parts. This will ensure that the safety of the product is maintained.
- Do not modify or attempt to repair the appliance except as indicated in the instructions for use and care.
- Do not store or use the appliance near high temperature areas.
- To prevent tripping accidents, store vacuum after each use.
- Do not expose the vacuum to outdoor elements.
- Do not place any object on top of the product or place the product on a soft surface that might block the ventilation slots and result in excessive internal heat. Place the product in a position away from any heat source. The charging circuit is ventilated through slots in the left and the right of the housing.
- . Do not operate the product with a damaged cord or plug.
- Do not operate the product if it has received a sharp blow, been dropped or otherwise damaged in any way.
- Do not disassemble the product; take it to an authorized service center when service or repair is required. Incorrect reassembly may result in a risk of electric shock, electrocution or fire.
- Disconnect the plug from the outlet before attempting any cleaning. This will reduce the risk of electric shock.
- If the vacuum requires cleaning, unplug the plug, switch off the unit.
   Do not use cleaners or solvents to clean the exterior of the vacuum. Use only a damp or dry cloth.
- For safety reasons, this vacuum is designed to power off if the motor overheats. If this occurs, please switch the power off and unplug the unit to allow the motor to cool down before using again.


#### **GOOD TO KNOW**

#### HELPFUL HINTS

- DO empty the dust bin and clean the filters regularly for optimal operation of the vacuum.
- DO keep hair, loose clothing, fingers, feet and body parts away from openings or moving parts.
- **DO** disconnect the appliance from the mains supply before storing.
- DO turn off controls before you connect or disconnect the appliance to or from the power supply.
- DO disconnect the appliance from the power supply when not in use, before changing the filters, cleaning the filters or connecting/disconnecting the accessories.
- DO use only on dry, indoor surfaces.
- DO use only as described in this manual. Use only manufacturer's recommended attachments.
- DO keep cord away from heated surfaces.
- DO keep all openings free of dust, lint, hair, and anything that may reduce airflow.
- DO use extra care when vacuuming on stairs.
- DO keep your work area well lit.
- DO ensure children and babies cannot play with plastic bags or any packaging materials.
- DO operate the appliance from a power source of the same voltage, frequency and rating as indicated on the product identification plate.
- If this appliance is used by a third party, DO supply the instruction manual with it. No liability can be accepted for any damage caused by non-compliance with these instructions or any other improper use or mishandling of appliance. This product has not been designed for any uses other than those specified in this manual.
- DO NOT modify the polarized plug to fit a non-polarized outlet or extension cord.
- **DO** keep appliance on a level surface.
- ONLY for domestic use. Industrial or commercial use invalidates the warranty.



## **GETTING TO KNOW YOUR 2-in-1 VACUUM**



**CAUTION:** Do not plug in your vacuum cleaner until you are familiar with all instructions and operating procedures.

## **ASSEMBLY**



**CAUTION:** Always disconnect the appliance from the electric outlet before assembling or disassembling unit or accessories.

#### STICK VACUUM SETUP

Insert the end of the extenstion pole into the main body (A). Then, align the plug (B) at bottom of extension pole with floorhead until you hear a "click" to secure pole.

**NOTE:** To remove extension pole from the main body press the POLE RELEASE button and pull the main body from pole.



2 Attach the FLOOR HEAD to the open end of the dust bin aligning the pins to the holes. Proper connection is needed to operate the LED lights and floor head for carpeted and hard surface floors.

To **DISCONNECT**, unplug unit from power outlet and remove the floor head by pulling it apart from the dust bin.


#### **SELF-STANDING STORAGE**


- 1 Press extension POLE RELEASE button (C) and remove main body with handle. Keep the floor head attached to pole in the upright position.
- 2 Hang the main body by the handle to the STORAGE HOOK (D) on the pole.
- 3 Use the upper and lower hooks to neatly wrap the cord.

## **OPERATION**

#### **POWERING UP**

- Plug power cord into AC outlet.
- 2 Press POWER button (E) on handle.
- 3 Select MODE by pressing soft-touch button n handle (Carpet or Floor icon will illuminate).

# **OPERATING INSTRUCTIONS**

#### TO USE AS A FLOOR VACUUM

- 1 Assemble all parts and include the floor head with turbo-powered brush.
- Plug the floor vacuum into a standard AC outlet.
- Operate the floor vacuum slightly angled back or in swivel mode right or left to easily maneuver under or around furniture and obstacles.

NOTE: Five (5) bright LED lights on floor head help to illuminate the cleaning path while operating.



#### TO USE AS A HAND VACUUM

- 1 Ensure the appliance is switched OFF and unplugged from the power outlet.
- 2 Press POLE RELEASE button and pull the handle from the main body.
- 3 Plug back into the AC power outlet with or without any of the attachments.
- Use the unit as a handheld vacuum cleaner to clean sofas. stairs and hard-to-reach places.
- 5 Switch between the pet lint brush tool or mini motor-head for upholstered surfaces.

**NOTE:** A built-in LED beam helps illuminate dark corners. car interior and other spaces devoid of light.

#### **MULTI-SURFACE VACUUM**

- 1 Unplug vacuum before converting handheld vacuum to multi-surface vacuum for stairs and other flat areas.
- 2 Reattach the floor head without the extension pole.
- 3 Plug into AC outlet near stairs, or other level surface areas.

#### ACCESSORY ATTACHMENTS

- Use the provided MINI MOTOR-HEAD tool for upholstery, stairs, and smaller spaces.
- Use the LINT BRUSH attachment on fabrics, curtains, cushions and more delicate surfaces. Avoid adding pressure to allow the brush to help with the suction on textiles.

# **CLEANING AND MAINTENANCE**

#### **EMPTYING AND CLEANING**

To achieve the best performance, empty the dust bin and clean the dust bin filter after every use. Always switch off and unplug the appliance from the AC power outlet before any maintenance or cleaning.



If suction power seems to diminish, it may be time to empty the dust bin or clean or replace the filter.

1 To remove the DUST BIN, press down on the dust bin release button (A) (bottom of bin).


2 Empty the debris from the dust bin. Close Dust Bin lid until you hear "CLICK".





#### CLEANING PERFORMANCE FILTER

- 1 Press the EJECT button (B) on the top of unit to access the filter assembly.
- 2 Detach dust bin compartment and remove filter assembly (c).
- 3 Remove filter assembly and press on the locking tab (D) on the top of unit to access foam filter.
- 4 Insert fingers into gap on the sides of the filter assembly (E) and remove foam filter casing. Remove the foam filter from casing.










# **A WARNING:** NEVER OPERATE THE APPLIANCE WITHOUT DUST BIN PLACE.

- 6 Clean the unattached foam filter and dust bin under running water. Dry thoroughly. Do not use abrasive or chemical cleaning agents.
- 6 Replace the foam filter into casing and place filter assembly back into the dust bin. Reattach the dust bin to the main body by aligning bottom clip (F) of unit and click into place.



#### **CLEANING HEPA FILTER**

- 1 Toggle Release button  $\bigcirc$  on the bottom of unit to detach cover and remove the HEPA filter  $\bigcirc$ .
- Rinse filter with water and wait until completely dry. Re-insert filter into unit, close cover until you hear a "CLICK."



WARNING: Do not operate cleaner with damp or wet filters or without filter in place.
